## **Teaching and Learning Methods:**

This course is a demonstration of infusion of appropriate Early Childhood Teaching Competencies, under guided supervision. Students will utilize their content knowledge and learning approaches in their own classrooms to make connections between theory and practices.

The training will be conducted on child-centered methodologies - Play-based approaches to teaching, learning and assessment. A range of strategies will be used in the training sessions, such as:

- Show & Tell
- Hands on Activities
- Peer Learning
- Class Debates, and
- Group Discussions

Participants will be guided and assessed on the delivery of the lessons introduced.
