# **Course Title: School Enterprise Course**

## **Prerequisites**

This course is designed for community resource persons, social entrepreneurs and youth activists. Candidates meeting the following prerequisites may apply:

- HSSC certificate with grade C or above in English, Math & Science
- Be aged 18 years or above
- Pre entry work experience in a school as a teacher or a principal is preferred.

All applicants will be assessed for entry on individual merit or interview

#### Duration

The course comprises of four modules and the total course duration is 20 days.
